- HVAC Journeyman License through the State of Kentucky or Ohio.
- Current driver's license.
- Strong communications/interpersonal skills.
- The ability to regularly move, lift, and carry objects weighing up to 50 pounds, including ductwork, furnaces, and related materials.
- Willingness and ability to work evenings and weekends.

Preferred Credentials:

- High school diploma or GED equivalent.
- Two or more years of electrical/HVAC service training, or completion of an approved training program.

All candidates are required to undergo pre-employment drug screen and employment background checks.
